ADULT AWARDS



The **SCOUTERS KEY** award was started in 1927 and has evolved since then into the award it is today. The requirements vary depending on the position you earn it in, but in its essence, it is an award for Scout Leaders who create or maintain a quality program for a period of 3 or more years.



SEA SCOUTS AWARDS

The **LONG CRUISE BADGE** may be earned by both youth and adults registered in Sea Scouts. A Sea Scout must be Ordinary rank before he or she can start recording cruising time for the Long Cruise badge. The Sea Scout must cruise for two weeks on any vessel or boat provided by the local council or the ship, or their own vessel when authorized by an adult leader in that Sea Scout ship.

SCOUTS BSA AWARDS

The **WILLIAM T HORNADAY** Award recognizes Scouts and Scouters for ecology efforts and service to conservation in their communities.

There are seven levels to this award

- Unit Certificate
- Bronze Medal
- Silver Medal
- Gold Badge
- Gold Medal
- Gold Certificate

Think of this award as an Olympic medal bestowed by the Earth.



CUB SCOUT AWARDS

The **SUPERNOVA** award is an amazing looking extension of the **NOVA** award in Cub Scouts. You can earn 2 different medals, one as a **Wolf** or **Bear**, the other as a **Webelos**. The requirements for the medals are fairly rigorous, but more within reach than you might realize, while still completing a normal Cub Scouting Advancement program!



VENTURING AWARDS



The **RANGER** Award exemplifies a challenging high-level outdoor/high-adventure skills advancement program. Once earned, it will identify a Ranger as a person who is highly skilled at a variety of outdoor sports and interests, trained in outdoor safety, and ready to lead or assist others in activities.
